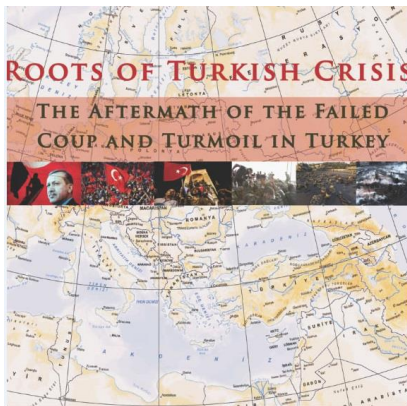

She specializes in contemporary Islamic movements. She published various scholarly articles, and wrote and co-edited a number of books. She is also an author of the Roots of the Turkish Crisis article recently published in the Democracy Journal where she provides insight into what's brought Turkey to this point – and where it may head from here.
